MEHA Scholarships

MEHA offers two scholarships each year to encourage and support emerging environmental health champions. The Mary Lauren Olson scholarship is a memorial scholarship given to a University of Minnesota School of Public Health graduate student contributing to the field of injury prevention. The Northstar scholarship goes to an undergraduate student enrolled in a program that makes them eligible to become a registered environmental health specialist, and who has connections to Minnesota. Scholarship awards are typically ~\$1000. Fundraisers for the scholarship funds are undertaken each year at MEHA's professional conferences.
